- The International Legal Order

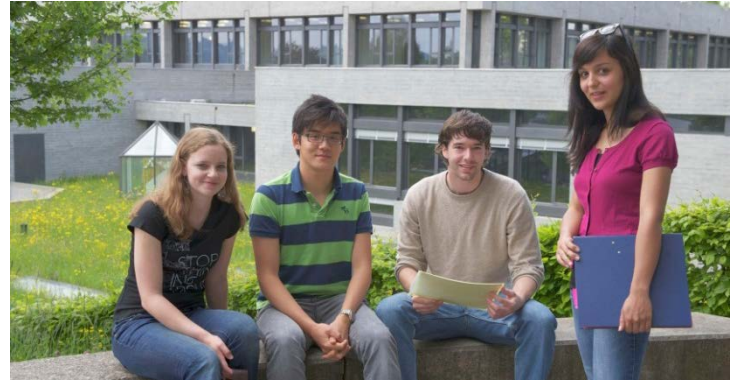
Elective Studies (24- 36 ECTS)

Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree in Law
- Bachelor's Degree in a similar field (at least 30 ECTS legal studies).
- Supplementary work may be required

Additional Requirements for Graduation

- Knowledge of two foreign languages
- Sufficient skills in Financial Accounting

Next Steps

Studies start two times per year either in autumn or spring. It is recommended to start in the autumn-semester.

Application Dates:

- Start in autumn-semester: 1. February until 30. April.
- Start in spring-semester: 1. September until 30. November.
